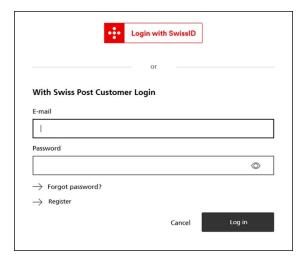
My Post 24 and PickPost

Finding an address for receiving mail

Thanks to the My Post 24 and PickPost services, you can flexibly manage how you receive parcels and registered letters. For this to work, you need to have a customer account, and items need to be addressed correctly.

Create customer account

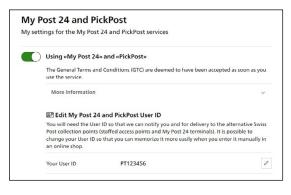
- 1. Navigate to the "My Post" customer portal.
- 2. Select "Register" > "Register with SwissID" and enter your personal details.
- 3. After registering, you will receive a six-digit code by e-mail which you will need to enter on the Swiss Post Customer Login page. By doing so, you will activate the details you have registered.
- 4. Within three working days, you will receive a code to verify your address and subsequently your account.
- 5. You have completed the registration and verification process.

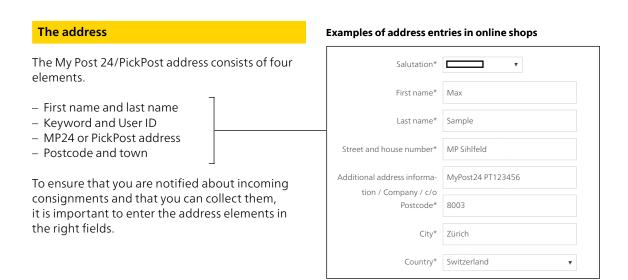


Find your User ID

You need your User ID in order to provide the correct address in online shops when sending your consignments to My Post 24 terminals or PickPost access points. You can find your User ID in the "My Post" customer portal, where you can edit and change it if required.

My Post 24 and PickPost settings





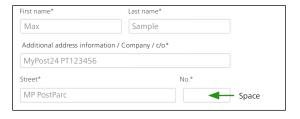
Are there only three available address lines?

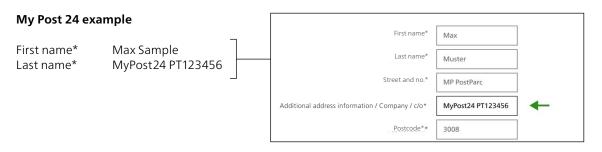
In the "First name" field, write your first and last name and in the "Last name" field, write the keyword "MyPost24" or "PickPost" depending on the service you have chosen, followed by the User ID.

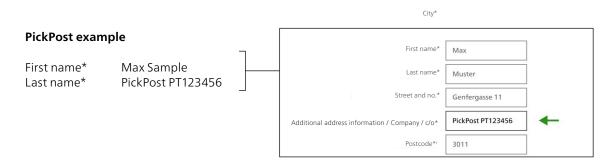


Does the online shop require a house number, even though the address of the My Post 24 terminal or PickPost access point does not have one?

Leave the house number field blank if possible or try entering a space instead of a digit.







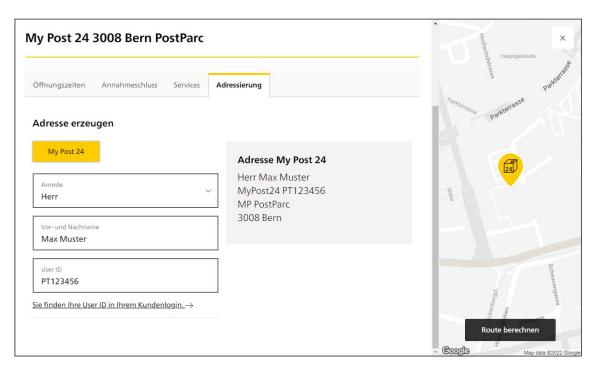
Please write the specific service as a single word (MyPost24 or PickPost) and on the same line as the User ID. If there is not enough space on a single line, write the service and user ID as a single word, e.g.: MyPost24PT123456 or PickPostPT123456.

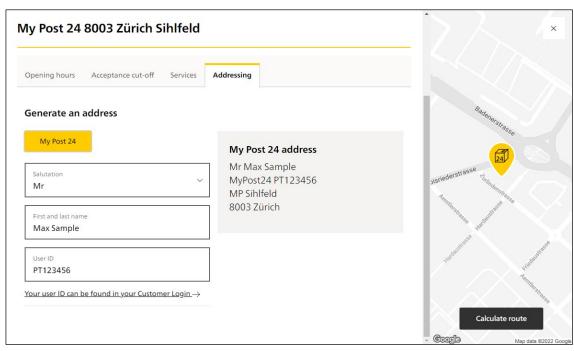
Finding the location address

The correct address format can be found in the "Addressing" tab.

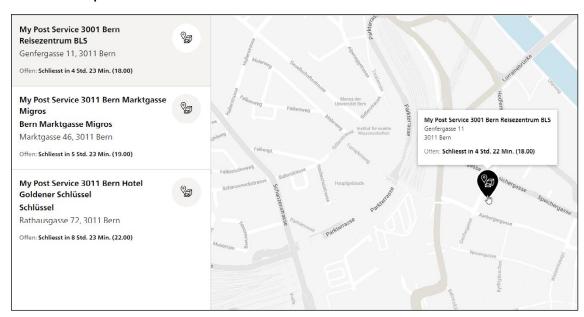
My Post 24 example

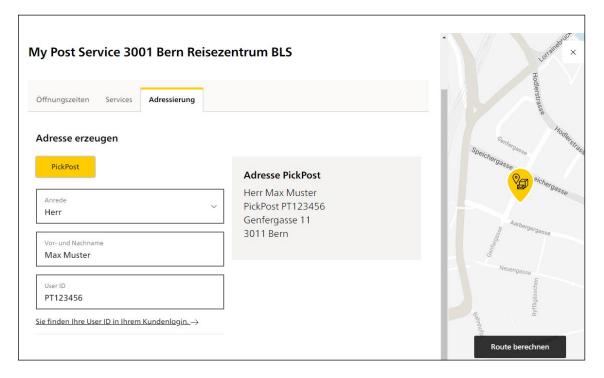
